

## Biz Pay Browser Security Requirements for 128 bit SSL

Whichever browser version you use, it must support 128-bit encryption (also called "strong" or "domestic" or "U.S." encryption). The 128-bit version of a web browser gives you the highest level of protection possible whenever you use our online application over the Internet. To check the encryption strength of your browser, follow these instructions:

### Internet Explorer

- From the menu bar choose "Help" then choose "About Internet Explorer."
- Look for the cipher strength information.
- If the cipher strength is 40-bit, you will need to upgrade your browser.

Figure 1 Internet Explorer Version 6

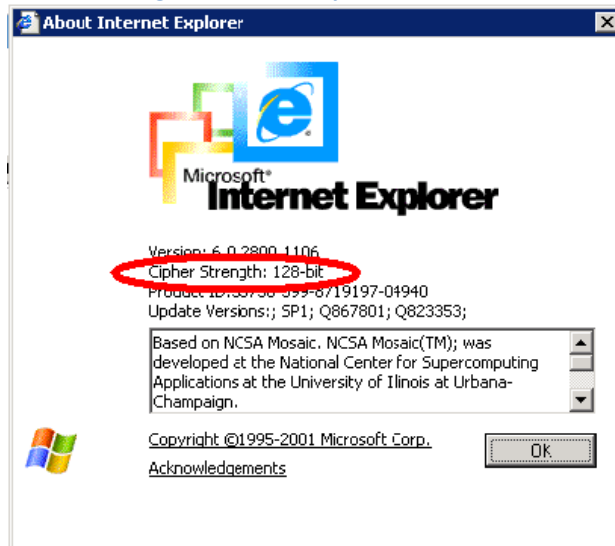


Figure 2 - Internet Explorer Version 6
